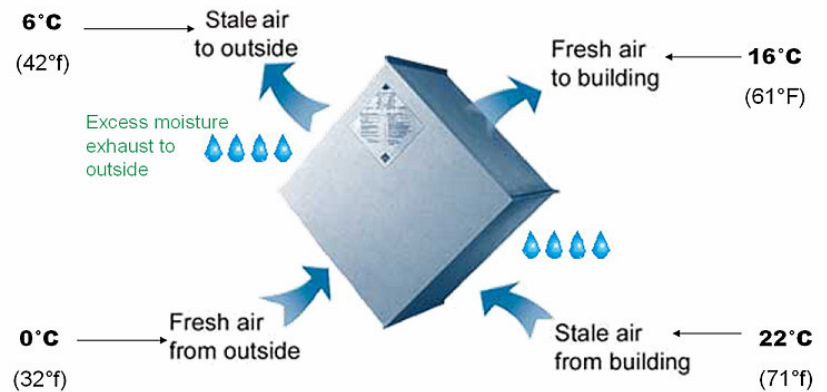

✍ An HRV system allows fresh outdoor air to circulate throughout your whole home (not just the rooms where a window might be open).

✍ How effective is an HRV? If it's 0°C outside and 22°C inside, an HRV will warm that 0° air up to 16° before it brings it indoors.

✍ Do you see water running down your windows? This is a sign of excess humidity. Today's houses are built so airtight that humidity gets trapped inside. As a result, condensation forms on your windows and doors which can cause moisture damage to window frames and surrounding walls. An HRV expels this excess humidity.

✍ Basements are a magnet for humidity so they can become a breeding ground for mold and mildew which can cause damage (not to mention a bad odor). By properly ventilating your entire home with an HRV, excess humidity is safely vented outside.

Protect your health - breathe cleaner air!

✍ Indoor air can be more harmful than outdoor air – up to 100 times more pollutants can be found indoors i.e. dust mites, mold, fungus, bacteria, cooking and cleaning gases. The answer is to ventilate your home with an HRV to bring in fresh air from the outside to dilute these pollutants and replace the stale air.

✍ Poor air quality can trigger health problems such as headaches, fatigue, poor concentration and respiratory ailments and can also aggravate existing problems. Today's new homes are built so airtight they require ventilation equipment such as HRV's to breathe. Like lungs, HRV's bring in fresh air and expel stale, polluted air.
