* **Cool Savings** – All equipment must be EnergySTAR rated and installed between 1/1/2010 and 12/31/2010. For more information visit their website: www.coolsavingsrebate.com.

** **EcoENERGY** – These rebate amounts are available only if you had your initial ecoENERGY assessment before April 1, 2010 and are still eligible for your 2nd assessment. (The 2nd assessment must be completed within 18 months of your first assessment, or, before March 31, 2011, whichever date comes first.) For details visit www.oe.nrcan.gc.ca.

*** **Home Energy Savings Program**
Scenario #1: If you meet the eligibility requirements for the ecoENERGY program above, then you will automatically be eligible for these grants.
Scenario #2: If you do not meet the eligibility requirements for the ecoENERGY program above you will need to book an ecoENERGY assessment for these grants. An accredited energy advisor visits your home and provides you with a report on ways to make your home more energy efficient. After you've completed any, or all, of the recommended upgrades, the advisor returns to your home to verify the equipment upgrades. You will also receive a grant for up to \$150 of the cost of your initial audit.
